## **PURPOSE:**

To establish guidelines for the safe and effective use of resources (apparatus and personnel) at an electrical fire.

## **Incident Operations:**

In conjunction with the Incident Priorities, Operations shall be determined by priorities set by R.E.C.E.O. V.S. as listed below:

Rescue Exposure	Ventilation
Confinement	
Extinguishment	Salvage
Overhaul	

## **General Guidelines:**

Roles and Responsibilities of the Engine Company(s):

- Control the spread of fire with the use of a dry chemical agent(s)
- DO NOT USE WATER BASED EXTINGUISHING AGENTS

Roles and Responsibilities of the Ladder Company

• Secure utilities – If utilities cannot be controlled due to the nature of the operations of certain commercial building and/or structures, work with onsite representatives to determine the best way to extinguish and control the electrical fire.

Once the electrical hazard is controlled and power has been secured, the incident/fire should be controlled as described in SOG's specific to the remaining problems.
