Purpose:

To establish a guideline for the use of in-vehicle repeaters (VRS).

Procedure:

This guideline shall be utilized at <u>all</u> incidents (including fire and EMS), events, or trainings where radio communication is needed, or could be needed by personnel.

Upon arrival the first arriving apparatus equipped with a VRS shall perform the following:

- 1. Give the initial radio report/and or size up, and then announce "Repeater is Active"
 - a. Example: Buxton Car 1 is on scene, with a 2 ½ story residential home, nothing showing from 3 sides; Car 1 establishing Portland Road Command, Repeater is Active.
- 2. Ensure the apparatus' mobile radio is not in scan mode, and is on Buxton Primary.
- 3. Activate the VRS by flipping the toggle switch to the "ON" position.
- 4. All other apparatus arriving on scene should also activate their VRS with the same procedure.
- 5. All personnel arriving on scene shall switch portable radios to VRS for the duration of the incident.
- 6. At anytime a VRS is not on scene, not activated, or is not working properly, all personnel shall use the Buxton Primary channel in their portable radios.
- 7. When the incident has been terminated, all VRS shall be returned to the "OFF" position.
